3.7 million passengers passed through Dublin Airport during July. 6.8% higher than the same month last year and our busiest July on record.



45 scheduled airlines operated at Dublin Airport last month.



There were 194k connecting passengers in July.



The number of passengers travelling to and from the UK in July reached 920k - a **4.8%** increase on last year.



Passenger volumes to and from North America in July reached 527k - a 13.6% increase on last year.

01 JULY - CANADA DAY



Celebrating Canada Day, we take the opportunity to look further at this key market from Dublin Airport. With strong transatlantic connections and growing passenger demand, Canada remains a key market for Dublin Airport.

MARKET **PERFORMANCE**

- This is a record year for the Canadian market with an increase of 6% YoY and 18% above 2019 levels.
- There will be nearly **700k** seats in the Dublin to Canada market in 2025 (694k to be exact).
- Since 2014, when our third carrier Westjet entered the market, we have seen growth of 480%.
- We had **588k** passengers in 2024 with 615k forecasted for 2025.

► CAPACITY FROM

- Dublin has the 8th most capacity to Canada from European airports.
- Dublin Airport has **four** airlines with **nine** routes to **six** destinations in Canada

Calgary | Halifax | Montreal St. John's | Toronto | Vancouver

- We have up to **eight** departures per day from Dublin to Canada in peak Summer.
- Almost 30% of all Canadian visitors visit Northern Ireland, making Canada the third-largest source market for Northern Ireland.
